

Full-time Research Assistant Position in Health Economics

[Prof. Maya Rossin-Slater](#) and [Prof. Adrienne Sabety](#) at Stanford's Department of Health Policy seek to hire a highly skilled individual to work as a full-time research assistant. The position will start in June 2025, although the exact starting date is flexible and negotiable. The position is for a one-year term with the possibility of renewal for a second year.

The research assistant will work on projects that primarily use administrative Medicaid claims data. One example is a project studying the impacts of children's access to school-based health centers on healthcare utilization and outcomes. Required tasks will include writing code to clean, analyze, and visualize data; creating and formatting research output; conducting literature reviews; and active participation in regular research team meetings.

This position is ideal for a candidate interested in pursuing a PhD in economics or health policy. A successful candidate should exhibit strong attention to detail, time management skills, fluency in a relevant programming language (preferably Stata, SQL, and R), and a willingness to learn new technical skills and gain knowledge in US health policy.

The position is based at Stanford University.
